

McKenzie Midwives Clinic Closeout Plan 4/27/23

Practice closure will be Friday, July 7, 2023 at 12:00 noon.

Coverage for patients with deliveries through May 26, 2023

- Midwife patient labor and deliveries will continue through midnight May 26, 2023.
- Postpartum clinic visits will be scheduled prior to hospital discharge.
 - The discharging midwife will contact the office to schedule before the patient leaves the hospital.
- OMG will cover all labor and deliveries after May 26, 2023.
- Women Services (4th Floor) will have the registry and instruct staff to contact OMG for all patients.
- Lactation services will be available through July 7, 2023.

Ongoing practice and clinic coverage now through July 7, 2023

McKenzie Midwives staff last day will be Friday, June 2, 2023.

- Summit Surgical Staff will cover phones and scheduling from June 5, 2023 – July 7, 2023.
 - Fax and phones will transition to Summit Surgical Monday, June 5, 2023.
 - Scheduling instructions developed by McKenzie Midwives staff.
- Lactation services are available through July 7, 2023; Jamie Core to transition to the hospital.
- Jamie Core will triage calls M-Th; other days, the midwife on-call will triage patient calls.
- Midwife call schedule will be maintained and updated as usual.
- Midwife Call shifts May 27, 2023 - July 7, 2023 will be practice coverage only.

Transition of care for patients with due dates beyond May 26, 2023

- **For patients with due dates beyond May 26, 2023** – Clinic staff is providing ongoing outreach to patients to coordinate transition of care based on available options.
- If the patient chooses, OMG is available:
 - Regardless of payer or status, OMG has capacity and has agreed to accept all McKenzie Midwives patients if they choose, which means that there is a viable plan for every patient if they choose.
- All patient transition plans will be documented in Athena.
 - Create an Athena patient case to document patient transition plan. Include OB care and delivery plan.
 - For quick reference, a note can be added in Athena to the alert box in the quick view screen.
